



# Wet Play In Schools

**The wet play programme enables schools to maximise on quality play opportunities during wet weather.**

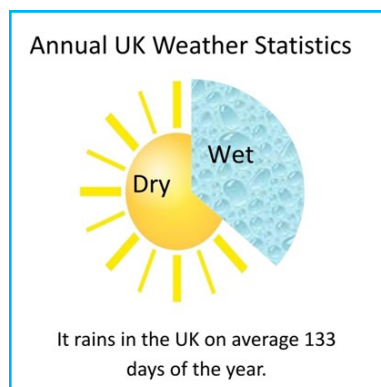
We have been working with schools and early years settings since 2007, helping them to create positive play environments for children. We are aware of the difficulties schools often have managing children's play when it raining heavily so have developed the wet play programme. This programme is a combination of training and development planning for lunchtime staff with input and support from senior leadership.



## What does it include?

The wet play programme aims to improve choices and freedom available to children, develop solutions to problems that can occur during wet weather and fully utilise the available spaces and resources for inside play. The package covers the following aspects:

- An overview of the Playwork Principles
- The value and importance of play in schools
- Barriers and solutions to children playing inside and outside when it is wet
- Review of current choices available inside and outside
- How children can have greater choice and freedom inside including a review of the current available space
- The input and ideas of the children
- Developing an action plan involving senior leadership and lunchtime staff
- A follow up and review of any implemented changes.
