



Crochet Hanging Basket

Yarn: Recycled Cotton Aran by King Cole

Hook: 5mm

Abbreviations:

(US terms)

Ch – chain

Dc – double crochet

Ss – slip stitch

Sc – single crochet

---- – repeat any instructions between stars

Tip: C3 counts as first dc of each round.

R1 – Ch3, ss together.

R2 – Ch3, dc 7 into middle, ss to join into circle. (8 st)

R3 – Ch3, dc into first stitch, 2dc in all other stitches, ss to join. (16st)

R4 – Ch3, dc into first st, dc in next st, *2dc in next st, 1dc in next st*, repeat til end, ss to join. (24 st)

R5 – Ch3, dc into first st, dc in next 2 sts, *2dc in next st, 1 dc in next 2 sts*, repeat til end, ss to join. (32 st)

R6 – Ch3, dc into first st, dc in next 3 sts, *2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts*, repeat til end, ss to join. (40 st)

You've now made the base of the hanger! Now to make it deep enough to hold a plant pot...

R7 – Ch4 (counts for 1st dc and 1 ch), skip st, dc into st after, *ch1, skip st, dc in next st* repeat til end, ch1, ss into 3rd chain from start of round.

R8 – Ch4 (counts for 1st dc and 1 ch), *dc in next ch space, ch1*, repeat til end, ss into 3rd chain from start of round.

R9 to R14 – repeat R8 until basket reaches right height for pot – remember it will stretch so take that into account!

R15 – Ch1, *sc in ch gap, sc in dc*, repeat to end, ss to join.

R16 to R18 – repeat R15.

Your main pot is now finished! The next round will form the 4 chains with which to attach it to a hook to hang from. These chains can be as long or as short as you need

R19 – *C60, sc all the way back down the chain, sc in next 10 st*, repeat 3 more times til end, ss to join.
